As a volunteer director/treasurer, you will play a strategic role on the CRHA Board of Directors. In this capacity, you will contribute in particular to:

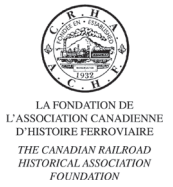
- guiding the organization's overall direction and supporting its mission;
